

Archdiocese of Toronto

To the faithful of the Archdiocese of Toronto,

Late this afternoon, the provincial government announced further restrictions to minimize the transmission of COVID-19, given the alarming increase in new cases over the past 10 days. The new measures have a direct impact on places of worship as part of an extended stay-at-home order, which will be in place until at least May 20, 2021.

As you are likely aware, the number of new cases, especially in Toronto, Peel and York, has increased

dramatically. While I firmly believe we offer an essential service and have demonstrated our ability to welcome the faithful safely given our stringent WorshipSafe measures, we must also recognize the serious nature of the current situation and respond out of love for our neighbour.

Restrictions for All Parishes in the Archdiocese of Toronto as of Monday, April 19, 2021

Parishes must restrict attendance inside the church to 10 people, including priests hearing confessions or a staff member/volunteer required to monitor capacity restrictions. **DUE TO THESE MEASURES, PUBLIC MASSES MUST BE TEMPORARILY CANCELLED.** Priests are asked to celebrate private Mass daily for the intentions of parishioners and for those suffering from COVID-19.

Churches, wherever possible and according to the judgement of the pastor, are encouraged to remain open for private prayer and for the faithful to receive the Reconciliation... Sacrament of WEDDINGS, FUNERALS AND BAPTISMS ARE RESTRICTED TO 10 PERSONS, INCLUDING THOSE WHO ARE INVOLVED IN MINISTRY (PRIEST, CANTOR, HOLY COMMUNION, FIRST *ETC*.). **FIRST** RECONCILIATION **AND CONFIRMATIONS** SHOULD BE POSTPONED AT THIS TIME. Please consult with your local parish as they develop their own plans in the coming days.

Virtual meetings should replace in-person meetings wherever possible. Parish offices will be operating with essential staff only ...

Given the alarming increase in new cases in recent days, people who are elderly, those with compromised immune systems or other health conditions are strongly encouraged to remain home. Livestreaming of services will continue where this practice is underway and the dispensation from the Sunday Eucharist remains...

I very much recognize the significant stress and anxiety that many people are feeling given the current situation and the frustration and spiritual pain inflicted by these restrictions over the past year. Be assured of my prayers as we face these challenging days. Please continue to pray for all those who are sick and those caring for them.

Saint Michael the Archangel, pray for us.

A WELL-INTENTIONED WARNING ...

Dear parishioners,

We invite you to follow the livestreamed masses from our parish. On Sundays, in addition to the mass in slovenian (8.30 am), we will have the livestreamed of the mass in english (10.00 am).

We invite especially the families of our Confirmandies and First Communion class to participate at home!

However I would like to draw your attention to a very important question. To present the problem to you, I would like to draw inspiration from a reflection of father Pokorsky.

The Mass is forever the "source and summit" of the Christian life and thus spiritually essential.

"Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you." (John 6:53) At the Last Supper, surrounded by his first priests, He commanded them "Do this in remembrance of me." (Luke 22:19) The components of the Mass are communal and personal. They are rooted in Jewish worship. The Liturgy of the Word fulfills and replaces worship in the synagogues, and the Liturgy of the Eucharist fulfills and replaces the Temple sacrifices with the One Sacrifice of Jesus. The reception of Jesus during Communion—his body, blood, soul, and divinity—prepares us to return to the world and to love others as Jesus loves us.

The Real Presence is Something we touch and experience:

That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon and touched with our hands, concerning the word of life—the life was made manifest, and we saw it... (1 John 1-2)

Jesus is present during the Eucharistic celebration in various ways: in the person of the priest, in the proclamation of the Word, and in the assembled people: For "where two or three are gathered together in my name there am I in the midst of them." (Mt 18:20) Above all, Jesus is present under the appearance of bread and wine after the Consecration: "... Christ becomes present

whole and entire, God and man" (Mysterium Fidei, no. 39).

The crisis in Catholic belief in the Real Presence is beyond dispute. The extended cessation of the public celebration of Masses throughout the country threatens to further undermine our faith. So it's understandable for pastors and diocesan bureaucracies to propose stopgap practices such as encouraging acts of "spiritual Communion" within the context of live-streamed Masses.

The Church has always advocated the practice of making a spiritual Communion" outside of Mass.

Homebound Catholics feel some connection to the Church when they watch Mass on TV or internet. So the growing recourse to live-streaming Masses may, at first, appear as a reasonable interim means to keep parishioners connected to their pastor and the daily celebration of the Mass. But there are distinct dangers to habitually "attending" Mass in the virtual reality of television and the internet and this may explain why some Catholics avoid streamed Masses. It's not real.

Some of the faithful-among them very pious folks -report that they "attend" Mass by watching the televised version. As a result -as many priests know-some seniors very gradually lose the desire to receive Holy Communion outside of Mass invoking their TV Mass "attendance." The lack of interest facilitates a priest's occasional neglect of his homebound visitation duties.

Hence even before the pandemic, television and internet broadcasts of the Mass tended to replace the Real Presence of Jesus in Holy Communion with his Virtual Presence (to coin a phrase). The great beauty of our sacred art, music, and architecture testifies to our need to receive the Sacraments within the context of transcendence. Mediation through a digital screen distances us from this reality.

One hopes those who view streamed Masses during these challenging weeks will return to the Real Presence celebrations when government and religious authorities once again permit church attendance. But appearances affect the cultural-religious zeitgeist for better or for worse. Culture flows from the cult, the form of worship.

Appearances accentuate or imply certain realities.

A LIVE-STREAMED MASS DOES NOT ANTICIPATE THE RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION; IT SUBSTITUTES FOR OUR COMMUNAL PARTICIPATION. Participation is decidedly passive—or completely interior/spiritual—which can be Protestant at best, gnostic at worst. The trajectory of these appearances may further erode the Catholic sense of need and desire for the Real Presence.

In 1979, Pope John Paul II encouraged priests in their sacred ministry. His words were remarkably prescient:

···think of the places where people anxiously await a Priest, and where for many years, feeling the lack of such a Priest, they do not cease to hope for his presence. And sometimes it happens that they meet in an abandoned shrine, and place on the altar a stole which they still keep, and recite all the prayers of the Eucharistic liturgy; and then, at the moment that corresponds to the transubstantiation a deep silence comes down upon them, a silence sometimes broken by a sob··· so ardently do they desire to hear the words that only the lips of a Priest can efficaciously utter. So much do they desire Eucharistic Communion, in which they can share only through the ministry of a priest....

During these unfortunate times, it seems better to emphasize the Real Presence of Jesus in traditional ways: in the gathering of two or three, reading of the Word, and a spiritual Communion—yearning for the Real Presence in better times.

SO EVEN WE FOLLOW THE MASSES ON TV OR INTERNET, WE MUST NOT ALLOW THE VIRTUAL REALITY OF ELECTRONIC IMAGES TO REPLACE OUR DESIRE FOR THE REAL PRESENCE.

GOING TO MASS ONLINE? 6 TIPS

- **#1. UNITE WITH OTHERS.** It's better not to follow the Mass alone, so try to do so with your family, or with at least one other family member. When everyone's focus is united, it's easier to concentrate. Choose the Mass time that best suits everyone's schedule, and make it a family event of the day.
- **#2. CREATE THE RIGHT SETTING.** Take care of the atmosphere in the room. For example, you could put a cross or an image of Our Lady near your TV or computer, and light a candle or two if you have some.
- **#3. GET DRESSED.** Dress for the occasion: you might be at home, but leave the pajamas for bedtime and the tracksuit for sports time.
- **#5. PRAY A SPIRITUAL COMMUNION.** Although you can't receive Jesus in the Eucharist, you can pray a spiritual communion. This is the one that Saint Josemar1

a used to pray: "I wish my Lord, to receive you with the purity, humility and devotion, with which your Most Holy Mother received you, with the spirit and fervor of the saints." But there are many others.

#6. WHAT'S THE RUSH? Don't be in a hurry: the Mass has incredible value, and right now there are so many things to pray for. Stay for a few moments after Mass has ended to pray for everyone: the deceased, the sick, health professionals, government officials and, of course, the Church, the Pope, our bishops and your parish.
